

CREZ 345KV TRANSMISSION LINE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS



Competitive Renewable Energy Zones ("CREZ") were introduced by the Texas State Legislature in 2005 to alleviate grid congestion and integrate renewable energy resources (primarily wind from rural west Texas) into more heavily populated metropolitan areas (e.g., Austin, Dallas-Fort Worth, San Antonio).

Approximately 2,400 miles of electric transmission line was

South Texas Electric Cooperative over a 3 year period.

Employing various Quanta network contracting configurations (Irby is a Quanta Services company (PWR:NYSE)), Irby collectively built approximately 1,000 miles of line, the majority of which was completed by December 2014.
